On February 3, 2016, the Commission's Staff filed a petition asking the Commission to determine whether Noranda Aluminum, Inc. has materially failed to comply with a condition required to access the reduced cost Industrial Aluminum Smelters (IAS) rate class. The report and order in Ameren Missouri's last rate case, which established the IAS rate class, requires the Commission to hold a hearing, or make a determination based on verified pleadings within 30 days of the filing of Staff's petition.<sup>1</sup> The Commission has previously ordered Noranda to respond to Staff's petition by February 9.

Because this case arises from Ameren Missouri's prior rate case, the Commission will make the parties from that case parties to this case.
