## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On April 17, 2020, The Empire District Electric Company, a Liberty Utilities company (Empire-Liberty) filed an application for approval of a Community Solar Pilot Program.<sup>1</sup> Empire-Liberty filed an implementing tariff, denominated Tariff No. YE-2020-0182, which bears an effective date of June 1. Empire-Liberty then filed voluntary extensions of the tariff effective date, the latest of which was October 15.

On September 15, Empire-Liberty withdrew Tariff No. YE-2020-0182, and filed Tariff No. YE-2021-0062. The Commission will order responses.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Staff shall file a Recommendation on Tariff No. YE-2021-0062 no later than September 22, 2020.
- 2. Any response to the Staff Recommendation shall be filed no later than September 24, 2020.
  - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
