ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

An evidentiary hearing in this matter is set for December 17 and 18, 2014. On December 12th, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and the Commission's Staff filed a *Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement*. That same day, the Commission issued an order setting a deadline of noon on Monday, December 15, 2014 for parties to file a request to suspend the procedural schedule. KCP&L timely filed a *Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule*. KCP&L's motion states that the other parties have authorized the company to file the motion on their behalf.

KCP&L and Staff also filed a *Second Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement*. KCP&L states the non-signatories are aware of the agreement and do not oppose it or request a hearing on the agreement. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(2)(B) gives parties seven days to file an objection to a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement.

The Commission will suspend the procedural schedule and cancel the evidentiary hearing set for December 17 and 18, 2014.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule in this file is suspended until further order of the Commission. The evidentiary hearing set for December 17 and 18, 2014 is canceled.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
