**MAWC STATEMENT OF POSITION**

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") and, as its *Statement of Position*, states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission"):

MAWC believes the COVID-19 pandemic is an extraordinary event within the scope of the Uniform System of Accounts. Accordingly, the Commission should approve Evergy's Application for an accounting authority order and permit Evergy to accumulate and defer to a regulatory asset extraordinary costs and financial impacts incurred as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

**WHEREFORE**, MAWC respectfully requests that the Commission consider this pleading and, thereafter, issue such orders as it should find to be reasonable and just.

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
