ORDER DIRECTING PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: May 12, 2021 Effective Date: May 12, 2021

On December 3, 2020, the Staff of the Commission filed notice that it started its first prudence review of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's costs associated with Demand-Side Programs Investment Mechanisms (DSIM) for Cycle 3 Energy Efficiency Programs and Cycle 2 Long-Lead Projects. In its report filed on May 3, 2021, Staff identified and recommended disallowance of certain costs and also recommended carryover of an adjustment, plus interest, from a previous MEEIA prudence review. On May 10, 2021, Ameren Missouri requested a hearing and asked the Commission to schedule a procedural conference.

The Commission will direct the parties to file a joint proposed procedural schedule. The parties should review the Commission's hearings calendar, posted at the Commission's website at https://psc.mo.gov, to identify conflicts with Commission hearings and other events on the Commission's schedule.

The proposed schedule shall specify whether the parties will pre-file testimony and, if so, propose deadlines. In addition, the proposed schedule must include deadlines for a joint stipulation of facts; joint list of issues and order of opening, list of witnesses and order of cross-examination; and position statements. The parties may presume all pre-hearing

filings will be due no fewer than 10 days before hearing, and transcripts will be available no earlier than 10 business days after hearing. Any requests for expedited transcripts should be submitted within the period provided for filing a proposed procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No later than May 26, 2021, the parties shall file a status report or a proposed procedural schedule as described above.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
