On April 15, 2021, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2021-2023 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan and 2020 Renewable Energy Compliance Report, as required by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8). Commission Staff are required to review RES compliance filings and report to the Commission within 45 days of the date of filing; the Office of the Public Counsel and other interested persons or entities may file comments within the same period.¹

On June 1, 2021, Staff filed a report indicating it found no deficiencies in Ameren Missouri's RES Compliance Plan. In regard to the RES Compliance Report, Staff identified deficiencies in Ameren Missouri's reporting of certain information about third-party renewable energy credits and recommended Ameren apply for variance of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(A)1.I.

No additional comments on Ameren Missouri's RES report and plan have been filed. The Commission will direct Ameren Missouri to respond to Staff's report.
