ORDER PROVIDING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND DIRECTING RESPONSE

On January 20, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a Request for Variance, asking the Commission to grant a variance from certain requirements of the Commission's integrated resource planning rule, 20 CSR 4240-22. Specifically, Ameren Missouri seeks a delay in the timing of filings required by 20 CSR 4240-22.080(12), relieving it from the rule's requirement that it file notice of changes to its preferred resource plan within 60 days of its determination that a change is required. Ameren Missouri explains that the rule would require such a filing to be made by February 9, 2022, but requests that it be allowed until July 15, 2022, to complete its studies and file an updated preferred resource plan.

The Commission will provide notice to potentially interested parties and the public, and will establish an intervention deadline. In addition, the Commission will establish a date for its Staff and other interested parties to offer recommendations regarding Ameren Missouri's request for variance.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to all parties to Ameren Missouri's most recent integrated resource plan triennial compliance filing, EO-2021-0021.
2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Division shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Ameren Missouri's service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing Ameren Missouri's service area.
3. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than February 4, 2022.
4. Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's Request for Variance no later than February 4, 2022.
5. Any other party wishing to respond to Ameren Missouri's Request for Variance shall do so no later than February 4, 2022.
6. This order shall be effective when issued.
