## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE IMPACT AND DIRECTING FILING

The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing the Data Center to send a copy of the Application to the clerk of the City of St Louis and directing Staff to file a recommendation.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 393.190.1<sup>1</sup>, the Commission must provide the appropriate county clerks with a copy of all information it has obtained as to what, if any, impact the sale proposed in the Application will have on the tax revenue of the political subdivision where such disposition is located. Paragraph 10 of Application only references the City of St. Louis as an impacted county<sup>2</sup>.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Data Center shall send a copy of the Application to the circuit clerk of the City of St. Louis.

2. No later than August 9, 2013, the Commission's staff shall file its recommendation on the Application.


