## ORDER OPENING A CASE

On August 20, 2013, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to open a case to facilitate and retain discovery regarding Staff's audit of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operation Company's installation of equipment to reduce the emission of Nitrogen Oxides at the Jeffrey Generation Station. As Staff's motion explains, this is not a contested case. Any consideration of the prudence of GMO's investment will occur in a subsequent rate case and not in this case. The Commission will open a case as Staff requests.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This case is opened to facilitate and retain discovery regarding Staff's audit of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operation Company's installation of equipment to reduce the emission of Nitrogen Oxides at the Jeffrey Generation Station.
2. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operation Company is made a party to this case.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
