**ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE**

On November 5, 2014, the Commission issued an *Order Approving Partial Stipulation and Agreement, Rejecting Tariff, and Establishing Procedural Schedule*. As a part of that order, the Commission approved, at the request of the parties, a procedural schedule to address two issues identified as remaining for Commission determination.

The Commission finds that a procedural conference is now appropriate. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. Parties wishing to appear by telephone will be provided with a telephone conference number. At the conference, parties should be prepared to discuss the nature of the relief requested, whether an evidentiary hearing is appropriate to resolve the remaining issues, and additional elements of the procedural schedule.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. A procedural conference shall be held on Wednesday November 19, 2014, beginning at 10:30 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Anyone needing additional
