ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

Issue Date: January 8, 2014

Effective Date: January 18, 2014

On December 26, 2013, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel Millicorp, Inc.'s ("Millicorp") registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri.

In File Number DA-2010-0056, the Commission granted Millicorp its IVoIP registration in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Millicorp notified Staff that the company has dissolved its corporate status in Missouri, and no longer wished to be registered as an IVoIP provider in Missouri.

On December 26, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than January 6, 2014. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹



Based on Millicorp's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVolP registration granted to Millicorp, Inc. shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services granted to Millicorp, Inc., in File Number DA-2010-0056, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on January 18, 2014.
3. This case may be closed on January 19, 2014.
