## **NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION AND CLOSING FILE**

On December 30, 2013, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the voice over Internet protocol registration of MegaPath Corporation, formerly Covad Communications. Staff filed the motion with the Missouri Public Service Commission in response to a notification for the discontinuance of service that MegaPath submitted to the Federal Communications Commission.


On January 3, 2014, MegaPath filed its *Response Opposing Staff's Motion To Cancel VoIP Registration* which clarified no services in Missouri would be affected. In addition, MegaPath stated they intend to continue providing broadband and VoIP services in Missouri.

On January 22, 2014, Staff filed a voluntary withdrawal of its December 30 Motion based on MegaPath's January 3 response and clarification.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits a movant to voluntarily dismiss its motion without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered. No

prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that Staff has withdrawn its motion. With Staff's motion having been withdrawn, no further action is required and this file may be closed.
