

Definitions for draft 4 CSR 240-22.070

() Critical uncertain factor means one of a set of uncertain factors which the utility decision-makers determine most materially affect the outcome of resource planning decisions. [KCPL: “Affects the selection of a resource plan” instead of “materially affect outcome of resource planning decisions” doesn’t want outcome to mean PVRR]

() Planning future means one of a set of planning futures defined in phase 1 of the risk analysis to represent the distinct future environments in which to assess the performance of each alternative resource plan. [UE: Is definition necessary? Defined in 070(3)]

() Top resource plans is a subset of the alternative resource plans identified in phase 2 of the risk analysis and includes those alternative resource plans which are expected to perform best overall in the planning futures defined in phase 1 of the risk analysis. The set of top resource plans should include the one or two best performing alternative resource plans in each planning future and shall include at least four resource plans. [UE: would one or two alternative plans limit the analysis? Refer top plans to candidate resource plans. May not need definition – instead describe process which includes ranking PVRR and then choosing others based on other performance measures and factors based on utility’s judgement.][DNR: call them candidate resource plans instead of top resource plans. Make sure that candidate resource plans are diverse enough. Drop definition. Describe process which would include allowing utility to add plans to increase diversity.]
