## STAFF RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its *Recommendation* states:

- 1. On April 22, 2019, Pulsar360, Inc. filed a *Notification of Transaction* between itself and a newly formed corporation, Pulsar360 Corp. Pursuant to the transaction, all of the assets of Pulsar360, Inc. would be transferred to Pulsar360 Corp.
- 2. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-28.011(2) notice shall be provided to the Commission to cancel certification(s) or registration(s) previously granted by the Commission. Notice should comply with the following requirements: (A) The company should submit written notice to the commission, as in a letter, containing the following information: (1) a statement requesting cancellation of a company's certification or registration and citing the specific certificates of service authority and/or registrations; (2) If the company also has a currently effective tariff, then the letter should also request cancellation of the tariff; (B) The letter can be signed by a company official and does not need to be signed or filed by an attorney; and (C) The letter should be electronically filed in EFIS.
- 3. The Company's initial filing consisted of a properly submitted letter to the Commission, filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS), bearing a request for cancellation of its authority to provide VoIP services in Missouri and signed by an officer of the company in accordance with the Commission Rule.

However, the Company failed to provide the date the new name had taken or would take effect, documentation that the new name was registered with the Missouri Secretary of State and a statement that it had reviewed and/or updated its contact information in EFIS so Staff requested an extension of the date by which to file its recommendation. The Company does not have a currently effective tariff so those portions of the rule were not applicable.

- 4. On May 21, 2019, Pulsar360 filed a supplemental filing including all of the necessary information in compliance with 4 CSR 240-28.011(2). Staff recommends that the Company has met all Commission rule requirements and recommends the Commission recognize the name change of Pulsar360, Inc. to Pulsar360 Corp.
- 5. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully recommends the Commission recognize the name change of Pulsar360, Inc. to Pulsar360 Corp; and grant such other and further relief as is just in the circumstances.
