20	Q.	WHAT IS YOUR EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND?

24	Q.	ARE YOU FAMILIAR WITH THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THIS CASE?	
25	A.	Yes, I am. This case involves the Missouri Public Service Commission's review of the	
26	Joint Application of AmerenUE and Gascosage Electric Cooperative ("GEC") requesting that the		

- 1 Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issue an order (1) approving a change in
- 2 electric supplier, for approximately 1200 structures in and around the cities of Brumley and
- 3 Ulman, from AmerenUE to GEC, pursuant to Section 393.106 RSMo. 2000; (2) authorizing the
- 4 sale, transfer, and assignment of certain substations and electric distribution facilities, easements,
- 5 and other rights generally constituting AmerenUE's electric utility business associated with said
- 6 structures, pursuant to Section 393.190 RSMo. 2000; and (3) approving the First Amendment to
- 7 the existing Territorial Agreement that was approved by the Commission by Report and Order in
- 8 Case No. EO-98-279 (hereinafter the "First Amendment" and "Territorial Agreement") pursuant
- 9 to Section 394.312 RSMo. 2000.

10 Q. WHAT RELIEF ARE THE APPLICANTS IN THIS MATTER REQUESTING

FROM THE COMMISSION?

11

- 12 A. AmerenUE and GEC are requesting that the Commission issue an order (1) approving a
- change in electric supplier from AmerenUE to GEC, for approximately 1200 structures in and
- around the cities of Brumley and Ulman, for reasons other than rate differential, and on the basis
- that this change is in the public interest; (2) authorizing AmerenUE to sell, transfer, and assign to
- 16 GEC certain substations and electric distribution facilities, easements, and other rights generally
- constituting AmerenUE's electric utility business associated with said structures, as more
- particularly described in the Contract for the Purchase and Sale of Distribution Facilities dated
- October 9, 2001 (the "Contract"), which is attached as **Schedule 1** hereto; (3) finding that the
- designated electric service areas of AmerenUE and GEC, as set forth in the First Amendment
- which is attached as **Schedule 2** hereto, are not detrimental to the public interest, and approving
- the First Amendment; (4) finding that the First Amendment shall not impair AmerenUE's
- certificates of public convenience and necessity, except as specifically limited by the First

- Amendment; (5) approving AmerenUE's changes to its tariffs as shown in its Illustrative Tariffs,
- which are attached as **Schedule 3** hereto; (6) authorizing AmerenUE to perform in accordance
- 3 with the terms of the First Amendment and the Contract, and entering into and executing all
- 4 other documents reasonably necessary and incidental to the performance of the transactions
- 5 which are the subject of the Contract, the First Amendment, and this Joint Application; and (7)
- 6 granting such other relief as deemed necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Joint
- 7 Application.

8 II. THE CONTRACT

- 9 Q. ARE YOU FAMILIAR WITH THE CONTENTS OF THE CONTRACT?
- 10 A. Yes, I negotiated the Contract for AmerenUE. I have attached as Schedule 1 to my
- testimony, a copy of the Contract between AmerenUE and GEC.
- 12 Q. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE CONTRACT?
- 13 A. In the Joint Application, AmerenUE and GEC are requesting that the Commission issue
- an order approving a change in electric supplier from AmerenUE to GEC, for approximately
- 15 1200 structures in and around the cities of Brumley and Ulman, for reasons other than rate
- differential, and on the basis that this change is in the public interest. The transferred structures
- and associated customers are identified in **Exhibit A** to the Contract. The Contract also provides
- for an orderly method of transferring said structures from AmerenUE to GEC and it is the legal
- instrument that sets forth the terms and conditions under which AmerenUE sells, transfers and
- assigns to GEC, the substations, electric distribution facilities, easements and other rights
- 21 generally constituting AmerenUE's electric utility business associated with said structures. The
- specific facilities to be transferred are identified in **Exhibit B** to the Contract, and those assets
- specifically not included in the transfer to GEC, are identified in Exhibit C to the Contract.

Q. DOES THE CONTRACT EXCHANGE ANY STRUCTURES?

- 2 A. No, it does not. Section 393.106.2 RSMo. 2000 permits a change in electric supplier to a
- 3 structure permanently served by an electrical corporation, only by order of the Commission, on
- 4 the basis that it is in the public interest, and for a reason other than rate differential. In fact, one
- of the conditions precedent in Article III of the Contract is receipt of an order from the
- 6 Commission authorizing the change in supplier for approximately 1200 structures within and
- 7 around the communities of Brumley and Ulman. Thus, the actual transfer of the structures and
- 8 their associated customers, if approved by the Commission, will be accomplished by a
- 9 Commission order. Nevertheless, the Contract identifies the structures to be transferred in
- Exhibit A of the Contract, outlines the method of customer transfer in Article V, and defines the
- responsibility of the parties for interim operation in Article VI.

12 Q. BRIEFLY DESCRIBE THE METHOD OF STRUCTURE/CUSTOMER

13 TRANSFER.

1

- 14 A. After receipt of Commission approval, the structures and associated customers shall be
- transferred simultaneously with the physical removal of their associated electrical distribution
- facilities from AmerenUE's system and subsequently connected to GEC's system. This physical
- process is referred to as a "cutover." This method of transferring customers is flexible; it permits
- customers to be transferred in defined groups and the transfers can occur over time as AmerenUE
- and GEC cutover the electrical distribution facilities by line segments. At the time of the
- 20 customer's transfer, AmerenUE shall read the customer's meter and it shall issue to the customer
- a final bill, reduced by any applicable deposit.

1 Q. PLEASE BRIEFLY DESCRIBE THE PRINCIPAL TERMS OF THE CONTRACT

- 2 RELATED TO THE SALE, TRANSFER AND ASSIGNMENT OF FACILITIES.
- 3 A. The Contract provides for the sale of the facilities listed in **Exhibit B** of the Contract, and
- 4 their associated easements and other property rights, from AmerenUE to GEC, for a purchase
- 5 price that is stated in a letter from John W. Greenlee to Larry D. Merry dated October 1, 2001,
- 6 which is attached hereto as **Schedule 4.** These assets are being sold "AS IS" with no warranty of
- 7 any kind. The Contract in **Exhibit C** expressly identifies assets that, while presently used to
- 8 serve the structures listed in **Exhibit A** to the Contract, are not part of the sale to GEC.
- 9 Q. BRIEFLY DESCRIBE THE ASSETS THAT ARE BEING SOLD TO GEC.
- 10 A. The assets to be transferred to GEC include (1) the Brumley and Keethtown substations,
- 11 (2) approximately two hundred thirty (230) circuit miles of distribution facilities used to serve
- the structures that are transferred under this Agreement, which include approximately fourteen
- 13 (14) miles of 34 kV circuit with associated poles, insulators, cross-arms, conductors and other
- hardware, the remainder being 12 kV circuits with associated poles, insulators, cross-arms,
- conductors and other hardware, and associated property rights such as easements. Included in
- this inventory of distribution facilities are approximately: 5000 poles, 1000 transformers and 2.5
- 17 million feet of conductor.
- 18 Q. BRIEFLY DESCRIBE THOSE ASSETS THAT ARE NOT BEING SOLD TO GEC
- 19 AND THEREFORE ARE BEING RETAINED BY AMERENUE.
- 20 A. AmerenUE assets presently being used to serve customers in and around Brumley and
- 21 Ulman, not to be sold to GEC include: revenue meters with all associated AMR equipment, 34.5
- kV transformers, regulators, and reclosures, all transmission line facilities above 34.5kV, and the
- 23 Mobile N substation currently located at Keethtown Substation. In addition, AmerenUE will

1	retain all necessary distribution facilities in the area required to serve its customers not
2	transferred under this Agreement.
3	Q. WILL AMERENUE MAINTAIN FACILITIES IN THE SERVICE TERRITORY
4	OF GEC?
5	A. Yes. The Territorial Agreement permits this and AmerenUE will continue to have
6	facilities in its service territory beyond the boundaries of the Territorial Agreement. As I have
7	already mentioned, AmerenUE will continue to serve customers in GEC's service territory for
8	which it must maintain distribution facilities. AmerenUE may also have to construct additional
9	facilities through GEC's service territory to serve new loads beyond the area of the Territorial
LO	Agreement.
L1 L2	III. THE TRANSFER OF THE STRUCTURES AND ASSOCIATED CUSTOMERS IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST
L3 L4	Q. WHY DID AMERENUE ENTER INTO THE CONTRACT?
L5	A. AmerenUE entered into the contract with GEC because the transfer of structures and
16	associated customers, along with the First Amendment, provide benefits to all parties involved:
17	the transferred customers, AmerenUE and GEC. The customers benefit from increased reliability
18	and voltage support because of GEC's plans to upgrade and replace certain facilities in the area.
19	GEC benefits because of the expansion of its business. Finally, AmerenUE benefits because of
20	the economics involved with providing service to this area. AmerenUE cannot justify the
21	upgrades that GEC has planned and just the normal routine cost of maintaining and operating the
22	distribution facilities in this area does not allow for an acceptable level of financial return for
23	AmerenUE. Because of the geography and the arrangement of our physical facilities, this area
24	does not fit well with Ameren IE's distribution business plan

1 Q. WHAT ECONOMIC ANALYSIS HAS BEEN DONE TO ANALYZE THE

2 IMPACT OF THE SALE OF FACILITIES ON AMERENUE?

- 3 A. I analyzed the sale of facilities using AmerenUE's EVA EVALUATE program, version
- 4 2000.02. The results of the EVA EVALUATE show a positive benefit to AmerenUE during the
- 5 first five (5) years after the transfer of the facilities and customers, without crediting any benefit
- 6 attributable to generation savings, which is AmerenUE's internal acceptance criteria for entering
- 7 into a transaction of this type.

8 Q. WHY IS THE TRANSFER OF THE STRUCTURES AND ASSOCIATED

9 CUSTOMERS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST?

- 10 A. I believe that it is in the public interest to transfer the structures and customers in question
- from AmerenUE to GEC at this time, because the transfer (i) would improve electric service
- 12 reliability, (ii) responds to the previous customers' requests for improved service, and (iii)
- permits AmerenUE to prudently employ its capital resources.
- The transfer of customers and their related electrical distribution facilities would improve
- the reliability of electric service. Presently, AmerenUE serves many of the approximately 1200
- structures in Camden and Miller Counties it proposes to transfer to GEC from its Brumley
- substation. A radial 34.5 kV subtransmission line on public right-of-way feeds the Brumley
- Substation. This line also serves the Equiline pumping station in Pulaski County. The pump
- station and the Brumley Substation have a total of 21.3 miles of exposure on this radial 34.5 kV
- 20 line. After the transfer, GEC will connect the transferred facilities into the transmission grid of
- 21 Sho-Me Power Cooperative, its transmission cooperative. Sho-Me Power plans to build a looped
- 22 69 kV transmission line which will serve the area.

There are also customers in Miller County (those in and around Ulman and along
Highway C) that are presently served by AmerenUE by a long single-phase line. After the
transfer, GEC plans to build a three-phase distribution line north from Brumley through Ulman to
Highway 17 to provide better voltage conditions and reliability in this area and to supply future
three-phase loads. The existing 34.5 kV line will be utilized as a three-phase 12.47 kV feeder to
serve customers southeast of the Brumley substation. A single-phase line presently serves this
area. The three-phase line will improve voltage conditions and reliability in the area.

Mr. John Greenlee, General Manager of GEC, in his Direct Testimony will provide additional details on GEC's construction plans and its ability to serve the transferred area after the transfer.

In the past, the Commission has received complaints from customers in the Brumley/Ulman area complaining about the quality of electric service. Copies of these complaints are attached to my testimony as **Schedule 5**. Many of these complaints concerned the need to upgrade certain poles along Highway C. While AmerenUE has replaced some of the poles in question, after the transfer, GEC plans to replace approximately 700 poles that have deteriorated over time. I also would like to note, that some of these complaints inquire about transferring service from AmerenUE to GEC.

The transfer would also allow AmerenUE to efficiently employ its capital. The Brumley/Ulman area is located in our Lakeside District, which includes both rural and urban areas. The Brumley/Ulman area is rural in nature and it is located at the outer reaches of AmerenUE's service area. Because of geography and the location of AmerenUE's existing facilities, the cost to build redundant power feeds in this area is prohibitive. Capital spending of this nature also cannot satisfy internal AmerenUE criteria given the low customer density in the

- 1 area. Therefore, the transfer permits AmerenUE to employ its capital in the other areas to greater
- 2 effect.
- 3 IV. <u>CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION</u>
- 4 Q. IN THE REPORT AND ORDER ON REHEARING FOR CASE NO. EO-98-511
- 5 ET AL., THE COMMISSION OPINED THAT, IN THE FUTURE, ELECTRIC
- 6 SUPPLIERS WHO ENTER INTO TERRITORIAL AGREEMENTS INVOLVING
- 7 EXCHANGE OF CUSTOMERS SHOULD PROVIDE AFFECTED CUSTOMERS WITH
- 8 A PROCESS FOR DIRECT INPUT INTO THE TRANSACTION. WHAT EFFORTS
- 9 HAVE AMERENUE AND GEC TAKEN TO PROVIDE FOR DIRECT INPUT FROM
- 10 ITS CUSTOMERS AFFECTED BY THE TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT?
- 11 A. Both AmerenUE and GEC agree that it is desirable to obtain direct input from the
- potentially-affected customers early in the process. By soliciting input early, the customers'
- concerns can be identified, questions can be answered, and the terms of the Territorial Agreement
- 14 modified, as required.
- 15 Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE THE PROCESS USED TO INVOLVE AFFECTED
- 16 CUSTOMERS.
- 17 A. The affected customers were notified of this proposed transfer, from AmerenUE to GEC,
- on or about September 14, 2001. Enclosed, with the notification letter, was a rate comparison
- and a brochure explaining the proposed exchange and providing information about GEC. The
- 20 notification letter invited affected customers to meet representatives of the Applicants on October
- 21 20, 2001, from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM at the public school in Iberia. The Commission Staff and
- 22 Office of the Public Counsel received invitations to attend the informational meeting. Schedule
- 6 to my testimony is a copy of a typical customer notification letter, its attachments, and letters

- 1 informing the Commission Staff and Office of the Public Counsel of the informational meetings.
- 2 On the same day the letters were to be mailed, a joint news release was issued to inform everyone
- 3 in the combined service area of both companies of the proposed Agreement. While each
- 4 company was responsible to notify its customers/members, both companies cooperated in the
- 5 development of the notification letter and brochure.
- Next, AmerenUE and GEC held a customer informational meeting on October 20, 2001,
- 7 from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM at the public school in Iberia. Both AmerenUE and GEC felt that
- 8 customer input would be maximized by face-to-face meetings. During the meeting, personnel
- 9 from AmerenUE and GEC were available to answer customer questions.

10 Q. DID YOU PERSONALLY ATTEND ANY OF THE MEETINGS?

- 11 A. I attended the public meeting along with my associates, Bob Schnell, Supervising
- engineer; Janet Beck, Customer Service Supervisor; Gaye Suggett, Customer Service Advisor;
- and Lori Hoelscher, Customer Service Advisor. Representatives from GEC were also present at
- 14 the meeting.

15 Q. HOW WERE QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC HANDLED?

- 16 A. During the customer meeting, personnel from AmerenUE or GEC provided answers to
- each of the customer's/member's questions.

18 Q. DID YOU FEEL THAT THE MEETINGS WERE WORTHWHILE?

- 19 A. Yes. I felt the meeting was helpful in relieving some of the apprehensions and anxieties
- of changing electric suppliers. The meeting also gave AmerenUE customers an opportunity to
- 21 talk to GEC representatives.

22 Q. WAS THE COMMISSION INFORMED OF THE MEASURES AMERENUE WAS

1 TAKING TO INFORM CUSTOMERS AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSED

2 TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT?

- 3 A. Yes. As a matter of fact, a representative from the Commission Staff attended the
- 4 meeting and talked with many of AmerenUE's customers at that time. In addition, the Office of
- 5 the Public Counsel was notified of the meeting, by letter, on or about September 13, 2001.

6 V. THE FIRST AMENDMENT

7 Q. HAS THE COMMISSION APPROVED A TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT

8 BETWEEN AMERENUE AND GEC?

- 9 A. The Commission approved the Territorial Agreement between AmerenUE and GEC by
- 10 Report and Order in Case No. EO-98-279, which became effective on June 23, 1998. The
- 11 Territorial Agreement specifically designated electric service area boundaries between
- 12 AmerenUE and GEC for service of new structures in Camden, Miller, Maries, Phelps, and
- 13 Pulaski Counties.

14 O. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT?

- 15 A. The First Amendment is required because it updates the electric service territories for new
- structures to permit GEC to serve new structures in the Brumley and Ulman areas. Pursuant to
- the Territorial Agreement, all structures to be transferred pursuant to the Contract are located in
- the service area of AmerenUE. While this fact would not prevent the transfer of the existing
- structures under the Contract, it would prevent new structures in the area to be served by GEC.
- This is not desirable over the life of the Territorial Agreement. Therefore, to facilitate the
- 21 transfer and future service by GEC in and around Brumley and Ulman, AmerenUE and GEC
- desire to modify the designated boundaries of the electric service area of each company in
- 23 Camden and Miller Counties. To this end, the Applicants have entered into the First

- 1 Amendment, which is attached to my testimony as **Schedule 2**. All structures to be transferred
- 2 from AmerenUE to GEC, under the Contract, are located within the electric service area of GEC
- 3 in accordance with the First Amendment. AmerenUE cannot serve new customers in this area
- 4 after its approval.
- 5 Q. IDENTIFY, FOR THE RECORD, SCHEDULE 2 TO YOUR TESTIMONY.
- 6 A. Schedule 2 is the First Amendment between AmerenUE and GEC, without Exhibit 2, the
- 7 maps, because they have been previously filed with the Commission. The required metes and
- 8 bounds descriptions of the amended electric service areas of AmerenUE and GEC are part of the
- 9 Exhibits to the First Amendment.
- 10 Q. DOES THE FIRST AMENDMENT AFFECT, IN ANY WAY, ANY OTHER
- 11 ELECTRIC SERVICE PROVIDERS?
- 12 A. The First Amendment only establishes amended electric service territories for the
- Applicants in Camden and Miller Counties; it does not affect, in any way, the rights of or the
- service area of any other electric service provider.
- 15 Q. DO THE FIRST AMENDMENT OR THE TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT LIMIT
- 16 THE CONSTRUCTION OF TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES?
- 17 A. Neither the First Amendment nor the Territorial Agreement limit either company's right
- to construct transmission and distribution facilities, wherever necessary, including but not limited
- to, the electric service area of the other party, as the parties see fit in order to provide electric
- 20 service in their respective areas.
- 21 Q. DOES THE FIRST AMENDMENT CONTAIN ANY PROVISION TO ALLOW A
- 22 STRUCTURE TO RECEIVE SERVICE FROM ANY PARTY ALTHOUGH THE
- 23 STRUCTURE IS LOCATED IN THE ELECTRIC SERVICE AREA OF THE OTHER?

- 1 A. The First Amendment contains a provision that permits AmerenUE to serve new
- 2 structures in the Brumley and Ulman areas during the transition period after the Contract and
- 3 First Amendment have been approved by the Commission. In the event GEC cannot serve a
- 4 customer, AmerenUE will serve it. This provision provides for an orderly transfer of customers
- 5 and facilities and saves money and time spent on unnecessary line extensions.

6 Q. HOW LONG DOES THE FIRST AMENDMENT REMAIN IN EFFECT?

- 7 A. The Territorial Agreement's term is perpetual and this provision in not affected by the
- 8 First Amendment.
- 9 Q. WILL AMERENUE REQUIRE ANY ADDITIONAL FRANCHISES AS A
- 10 RESULT OF ENTERING INTO THE FIRST AMENDMENT?
- 11 A. No.
- 12 Q. WILL AMERENUE TRANSFER ANY FRANCHISES TO GEC PURSUANT TO
- 13 THE FIRST AMENDMENT?
- 14 A. No.
- 15 Q. ARE TARIFF CHANGES REQUESTED?
- 16 A. Yes. AmerenUE is also requesting that the Commission approve changes to the service
- area shown in AmerenUE's tariffs. Illustrative tariff sheets showing the requested changes are
- attached hereto as Schedule 3. The illustrative tariff for Miller County includes a note that
- reflects AmerenUE's right to serve customers pursuant to the terms of the existing Territorial
- 20 Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment. The illustrative tariff for Camden County
- reflects the fact that AmerenUE's rights and obligations to serve structures in Section 20 in
- Township 38N and Range 14W are limited by the First Amendment. This is the only section in
- 23 Camden County so impacted.

1 Q. DOES AMERENUE REQUIRE ANY OTHER CHANGES TO ITS CERTIFICATE

2 OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY?

- 3 A. Because AmerenUE has a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the entire
- 4 area it proposes to serve after Commission approval of the First Amendment, it is not requesting
- 5 any additions to said Certificate.

6 VI. THE FIRST AMENDMENT IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST

7 O. WHY IS THE FIRST AMENDMENT IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST?

- 8 A. The principal advantage of the Territorial Agreement is that it prevents duplication of
- 9 facilities in the affected areas. Prior to Commission approval of the Territorial Agreement, there
- was little or no duplication between AmerenUE and GEC. The Territorial Agreement essentially
- locked this benefit in place. This advantage is preserved by the First Amendment. There is no
- duplication of facilities in the Brumley/Ulman area at this time. Since GEC plans to use facilities
- received from AmerenUE to serve both the transferred customers and new members, and
- AmerenUE is precluded from serving in this area in the future, the advantage of preventing
- duplication of facilities is preserved by the First Amendment. The First Amendment allows the
- transfer of facilities required by the Contract to be implemented because AmerenUE will no
- 17 longer need facilities to serve new customers in the Brumley/Ulman areas.
- Finally, the First Amendment contains a provision that permits AmerenUE to serve new
- structures in the Brumley and Ulman areas during the transition period after the Contract and
- First Amendment have been approved by the Commission. In the event GEC cannot serve the
- customer, AmerenUE will serve it. This provision provides for an orderly transfer of customers
- and facilities and saves money and time spent on unnecessary line extensions.

VII. INTERVENTION

1

- 2 Q. HAS ANY PARTY INTERVENED IN THIS CASE?
- 3 A. Yes, two AmerenUE unions, Operating Engineers Local 148 and IBEW Local 1455 have
- 4 made application to intervene in this case. At this time, the Commission has not ruled on their
- 5 applications to intervene.
- 6 Q. WHAT IS THE IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED TRANSFER OF CUSTOMERS
- 7 ON THESE TWO UNIONS?
- 8 A. AmerenUE has a labor agreement with Operating Engineers Local 148 that remains in
- 9 effect until July 1, 2002, and a labor agreement with IBEW Local 1455 that remains in effect
- until June 30, 2003. The proposed customer transfer in this case has no immediate impact on
- both unions. In the long term, one can only speculate on the impact, if any, of this proposed
- 12 change.
- 13 Q. WILL ANY BARGAINING UNIT EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTED BY EITHER
- 14 OPERATING ENGINEERS LOCAL 148 OR IBEW LOCAL 1455, BE LAID OFF BY
- 15 VIRTUE OF COMMISSION APPROVAL OF THIS PROPOSED CUSTOMER
- 16 EXCHANGE?
- 17 A. No, for two reasons. First, we have a manning agreement with Operating Engineers
- Local 148 which stipulates the minimum level for staffing. We are currently just above that
- 19 level. Second, AmerenUE has made a commitment to downsize the workforce primarily through
- attrition. As with all changes, the effect of the customer transfer on the workload will be
- evaluated in context with all of the other factors that come into play concerning workload. This
- process exists today and is an ongoing process. If, in the future, the workload in the Lakeside
- 23 District requires a different level of staffing than what currently is in place, then AmerenUE will

- 1 move to adjust staffing accordingly. At all times, AmerenUE shall comply with any labor
- 2 contracts and agreements that govern such matters.
- 3 Q. ARE YOU ASKING THAT THE COMMISSION APPROVE THE CONTRACT,
- 4 FIRST AMENDMENT AND THE TARIFF CHANGES AS PRESENTED?
- 5 A. Yes.
- 6 Q. DOES THIS CONCLUDE YOUR TESTIMONY?
- 7 A. Yes, it does.

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement"), made and entered into the **9th** day of October, 2001, by and between UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY d/b/a/ AmerenUE, a Missouri corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "Seller") and GASCOSAGE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, a Missouri corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "Buyer").

RECITALS

- A. Seller and Buyer are authorized by law to provide electric service within the State of Missouri, including all or portions of Camden, Miller, Maries, Pulaski, and Phelps Counties.
- B. Seller and Buyer entered into a territorial agreement for the exclusive service areas in all or portions of Camden, Miller, Maries, Pulaski, and Phelps Counties (the "Territorial Agreement"). The Territorial Agreement has been approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") by Report and Order in Case No. EO-98-279, which became effective on June 23, 1998.
- C. Seller and Buyer entered into an amendment dated July 17, 2001, to the Territorial Agreement for the exclusive service areas in Miller County and a small portion of Camden County (the "First Amendment"). The First Amendment alters the "Exclusive Service Areas" of Buyer and Seller by permitting the Buyer to serve the structures transferred hereunder. For this Agreement to become effective, the Commission must approve the First Amendment.
- D. Seller now serves certain customers, which are identified in **Exhibit A** attached hereto, that are located in Buyer's "Exclusive Service Area" as set out in the First Amendment, and the parties agree that these customers would be more reliably served by Buyer and

- thus benefit public interest.
- E. Seller presently owns and operates the Brumley and Keethtown Substations (hereinafter referred to as the "Substations"), certain 34.5 and 12 kV distribution facilities and related secondary and service facilities (hereinafter referred to as the "Facilities"), which are more particularly described in **Exhibit B** attached hereto.
- F. The Facilities are situated upon right-of-way and easements through grant (hereinafter, referred to as "Easements").
- G. Except for those Facilities expressly excluded on **Exhibit C** attached hereto, Seller desires to sell and to transfer the Substations and the Facilities (hereinafter, collectively referred to as the "Assets") and to assign, to the extent that it may legally and contractually do so, its rights under the Easements related to the Facilities to Buyer, and Buyer desires to purchase and accept same, all pursuant to the terms, conditions and provisions hereof.

AGREEMENT

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I AGREEMENT DEFINED

The term "Agreement" shall mean this Agreement in its entirety, which is comprised of the following:

- 1. All written modifications and amendments to this Agreement
- 2. This Agreement executed by Buyer and Seller
- 3. **Exhibit A** List of Structures and Customers to Be Transferred to Gascosage Electric Cooperative
- 4. **Exhibit B** Union Electric Company Facilities to Be Purchased by Gascosage Electric Cooperative
- 5. Exhibit C Union Electric Company Facilities Not to Be Purchased by

Gascosage Electric Cooperative

All Exhibits referenced herein are hereby incorporated by reference into the Agreement, as if fully set out verbatim. The documents making up this Agreement are intended to be complementary and interpreted in harmony so as to avoid conflict, with words and phrases interpreted consistent with electric power industry standards. In case of any inconsistency, conflict, or ambiguity between or among the documents making up this Agreement, the documents shall take precedence in the order in which they are listed above.

ARTICLE II <u>PURCHASE PRICE</u>

- A. Agreement to Sell and to Purchase. Seller hereby agrees to sell and to transfer to Buyer, and Buyer hereby agrees to purchase and to accept from Seller, all of Seller's Facilities as set forth and described on Exhibit B and all rights, privileges and obligations pursuant to Easements and associated with said Facilities, except for those items that are listed on Exhibit C, which are thereby expressly excluded, excepted and/or reserved.
- B. Purchase Price. In consideration for the Assets, Buyer shall pay to Seller the agreed upon purchase price as stated in the letter from John W. Greenlee to Larry D. Merry dated October 1, 2001 (hereinafter "Purchase Price"). Buyer shall pay the Purchase Price by wire transfer to an account designated by Seller, in writing, prior to the closing date, without deduction for bank-related fees or service charges, on the Closing Date.

ARTICLE III CONDITIONS

A. **Effective Date**. This Agreement shall be effective as of the effective date of the Order of the Commission approving this Agreement.

- B. Overall Conditions. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Agreement is contingent upon all of the following having occurred no later than May 31, 2002. Said date may be extended by written agreement, signed by an officer of each party hereto:
 - 1. Approval of this Agreement by the Commission including, but not limited to, receipt of an order from the Commission (i) approving the Agreement, (ii) authorizing the sale of the Assets and assignment of the easements, and (iii) authorizing a change in supplier for 1200 structures, more or less, within and around the communities of Brumley and Ulman.
 - 2. Approval of the Board of Directors of Seller.
 - 3. Approval of the Board of Directors of Buyer.
 - 4. The execution of a Boundary Line Agreement (either in the form of a new agreement or amendment of a previous agreement), between Company, or its affiliate, and Associated Electric Cooperative that shall provide for the sale of electric power from Company, or its affiliate, to Associated Electric Cooperative for the Brumley and Ulman service areas.
 - 5. Approval by the Security and Exchange Commission, if required.
 - 6. Approval of the First Amendment by the Commission

ARTICLE IV TAXES

- A. Taxes Upon Transfer. Seller shall be responsible for transfer taxes prior to the transfer of the Assets to Buyer hereunder. Buyer shall be responsible for transfer taxes coincident with and subsequent to the transfer of the Assets to Buyer hereunder including, without any limitations, any sales tax imposed on the sale or transfer.
- B. **Property Taxes.** Buyer and Seller shall prorate the property taxes associated with the Facilities for the calendar year of the closing, based upon the Closing Date.

- C. Other Taxes. Seller shall be responsible for paying all license, gross receipts, and franchise taxes owed to the appropriate governmental agency on service to a customer until said customer is transferred to Buyer's facilities. Buyer shall be responsible for paying all such taxes thereafter.
- D. **Penalties and Interest**. Each party shall be solely responsible for any interest and/or penalties assessed as a result of a party failing to pay, when due, any tax which that party is responsible for paying, as provided herein.

ARTICLE V CLOSING AND TRANSFER OF FACILITIES AND CUSTOMERS

- A. Closing. Closing shall be on a business day no later than three hundred and sixty-five (365) days after the effective date of the Commission's Order approving the Agreement ("Closing Date"), and at such time and place as the parties mutually agree. If no agreement is reached, the closing shall be on the last business day before expiration of said 365-day period, during business hours, at a location of which Seller gives Buyer advanced notice.
- B. Title and Risk of Loss. Title and risk of loss shall pass on the Closing Date.
- C. Duties. At closing, Seller shall (i) deliver the documents of title, including a Bill of Sale to the Facilities and quit claims deeds for the Substations; (ii) deliver the assignment agreements and consents thereto, where applicable, for the Easements; and (iii) deliver the release Facilities and the Easements from all liens created by Seller which are of a definite or ascertainable amount which may be removed by the payment of money, including the lien of its indenture of Mortgage and Deed of Trust, dated June 15, 1937, as amended and supplemented ("Seller's Mortgage"), and shall have made a good faith effort to release the Easements from all such liens. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Seller shall have no obligation to release the following liens and encumbrances: (1) private and public utility and drainage easements; (2) rights-of-way for roads, alleys, streets, and

highways; (3) zoning regulations; and (4) building, lines and use or occupancy restrictions, conditions and covenants. At or before closing, Buyer shall wire transfer to the account of Seller the Purchase Price.

- D. **Recording Fees.** Each party shall bear the costs for recording fees for the instruments that it desires to record.
- E. Time and Method of Transfer of Facilities. Seller shall transfer all Facilities listed in Exhibit B to Buyer on the date of closing by a Bill of Sale, without regard to whether the line is energized by Buyer's system.
- F. Possession. Buyer shall have the right of possession of the Facilities and Substations (excluding those items as identified in Exhibit C) and Easements upon transfer of the Facilities, Substations and Easements on the date of closing.
- G. Customers. The Customers to be transferred are located in, within, and around the communities of Brumley and Ulman (collectively, the "Designated Areas"). The Customers shall be transferred simultaneously with the physical removal of their associated Facilities from Seller's system and subsequent connection to Buyer's system by Designated Area in accordance with the procedure set forth in Article V of this Agreement. Seller shall also issue to each customer served by the facilities sold pursuant to this Agreement, a final bill, reduced by any applicable deposit.
- H. Accounts Receivable. Seller shall retain all accounts receivable related to Seller's electric business at the time of closing and through the time that the customers are transferred from Seller to Buyer. Seller shall be entitled to receive all money paid to either Seller or Buyer on said account.
- I. Time and Method of Transfers of Easements. Seller shall transfer all Easements associated with a Designated Area to Buyer on the date of closing by executing an Assignment of Easements. Seller shall cooperate with Buyer to obtain the consent for such transfer from the granting party, if required.
- J. Final Bill. Seller shall read Customers' meters and provide a final bill to them for

service received. Security deposits and accrued interest existing at the time of transfer shall be credited to the customer on the final bill. If Seller does not receive payment of the final bill within sixty (60) days of the date of its remittance, it may identify Buyer as its agent to collect the accounts receivable. Buyer agrees to take all actions as may be necessary to collect the final bill including, but not limited to, the disconnection of service. Any payments on said accounts received by Buyer shall be remitted promptly to Seller.

ARTICLE VI INTERIM OPERATIONS

- A. Responsibilities of Buyer and Seller. After the closing, and until the customers are physically removed from Seller's system and connected to Buyer's system (hereinafter, the "Interim Period"), Seller will continue to provide maintenance of the Facilities, electricity, read meters and bill the customers. Upon connection to Buyer's system, the Buyer shall take over these responsibilities. Seller and Buyer agree to cooperate during this transition period in order to minimize any adverse impact on the customers.
- B. **Emergency Calls.** Seller shall respond to emergency service calls during the Interim Period. Thereafter, Buyer shall respond to all emergency service calls.

ARTICLE VII REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

- A. Seller. Seller represents and warrants to Buyer and agrees with Buyer as follows:
 - Title. Seller warrants to Buyer that Seller will transfer to Buyer good and
 marketable title to facilities transferred under this Agreement, free and clear of any
 security interest, liens, encumbrances, or adverse claim of any third party.
 - Licenses, Permits and Approvals. Seller will have applied for and/or obtained
 in due time before the closing hereunder, all necessary authorizations, licenses,
 permits, approvals and other official consents as may be required under law and

regulation for Seller's performance of its obligations hereunder.

- 3. Fitness of Property. The Facilities sold and transferred pursuant to this Agreement are sold by Seller and purchased by Buyer "AS IS," and SELLER DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, WHETHER STATUTORY, WRITTEN, ORAL, EXPRESSED, OR IMPLIED WITH REGARD TO THE FACILITIES, INCLUDING ALL WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, AND WARRANTIES ARISING FROM COURSE OF DEALING OR USAGE OF **TRADE.** In no event shall Seller be liable for any damages including, but not limited to, special, direct, indirect or consequential damages arising out of, or in connection with, the use or performance of the Facilities. Any description of the Facilities contained in this Agreement is for the sole purpose of identifying the Facilities, is not a part of the basis of the bargain, does not constitute a warranty that the Facilities shall conform to that description, and does not constitute a warranty that the Facilities will be fit for a particular purpose. No affirmation of fact or promise made by Seller, not contained in this Agreement, shall constitute a warranty that the Facilities will conform to the affirmation or promise.
- B. Buyer. Buyer represents and warrants to Seller that Buyer will have applied for and/or obtained in due time before the Closing hereunder, all necessary authorizations, licenses, permits, approvals and other official consents as may be required under law and regulation for Seller's performance of its obligations hereunder.

ARTICLE VIII RECORDS

Seller shall give to Buyer, Buyer's accountants, counsel and other representatives, during normal business hours, from the date hereof to the Closing Date, access to books, records, contracts and commitments of Seller related to this transaction and shall furnish Buyer, during such period, with information concerning Seller's affairs, as Buyer may reasonably request with respect to the various transactions contemplated hereby. In the event that, after closing, any controversy or claim by or against either party arises out of this transaction or the subject matter hereof, either

party shall make available to the other, copies of such relevant records as may reasonably be requested pertaining thereto.

ARTICLE IX FITNESS OF PROPERTY

Seller shall repair and maintain the Facilities in good state of repair through the date of closing, ordinary wear and tear excepted, and Seller shall not dispose of any of such items except in the normal course of business without the consent of Buyer. If, between the time this Agreement is executed and the closing, a significant portion of the Facilities is damaged or destroyed beyond normal wear and tear, Buyer and Seller shall attempt in good faith to achieve a mutually satisfactory agreement for the repair and restoration of such Facilities. In the event that Buyer and Seller cannot agree upon terms for the repair and restoration of such Facilities, either party shall have the option of canceling this Agreement. If any portion of the Facilities or Easements is taken through condemnation during the period between execution of this Agreement and the closing, Buyer shall be entitled to the condemnation award(s).

ARTICLE X INDEMNITY AND RELEASE

A. Buyer's Environmental Indemnification and Release.

1. Buyer shall indemnify, defend and save harmless Seller from and against any suits, actions, legal or administrative proceedings, demands, or against any suits, actions, legal or administrative proceedings, demands, claims, liabilities, fines, penalties, losses, injuries, damages, expenses or costs, including interest and attorney's fees, in any way connected with any injury to any person or damage to any property (including cost of studies, surveys, clean-up and any other environmental claim expenses) which arise out of the condition, operation or use of the Facilities or Easements, or any loss occasioned in any way by hazardous substances (as defined under any Federal or Missouri law) on the property or by the negligent or intentional activities of Buyer during or after Buyer's acquisition of the property. This indemnity specifically includes the direct obligation of

Buyer to perform any remedial or other activities required, ordered, recommended or requested by any agency, government official or third party, or otherwise necessary to avoid injury or liability to any person, or to prevent the spread of pollution, however it came to be located on the property (hereinafter, the "Remedial Work").

- 2. After the closing, and without limiting its obligations under any other paragraph of this Agreement, Buyer shall be solely and completely responsible for responding to and complying with any administrative notice, order, request or demand, or any third party claim or demand relating to potential or actual contamination on the premises. The responsibility conferred under this paragraph includes, but is not limited to, responding to such orders on behalf of Seller and defending against any assertion of Seller's financial responsibility or individual duty to perform under such orders. Buyer shall assume, pursuant to paragraph (1) above, any liabilities or responsibilities which are assessed against Seller in any action described under this paragraph (2).
- 3. Buyer hereby waives, releases and discharges forever Seller from all present and future claims, demands, suits, legal and administrative proceedings and from all liability for damages, losses, costs, liabilities, fees and expenses, present and future, known and unknown, arising out of or in any way connected with the condition, operation or use of the Facilities, Easements or Substations, any condition of environmental contamination on the property, and/or the existence of hazardous substances (as defined under Federal or Missouri law) in any state on the property, however they came to be placed there during or after Buyer's acquisition of property.
- B. Indemnity and Release -- Interim Period. The parties intend, that during the Interim Period, Buyer shall assume the risks of loss and all liability with respect to the Assets. Accordingly:
 - 1. For any and all claims, demands, obligations, losses, causes of action, costs,

expenses, attorney's fees, and liabilities, whether known or unknown, which Buyer had, now has, or may claim to have, arising out of the loss of or damage to any of the Assets during the Interim Period and caused by Buyer, its employees or agents and/or Seller and its employees or agents, Buyer does hereby release, acquit, and forever discharge Seller, its parent corporation and the directors, officers, employees, attorneys, and agents of Seller.

- 2. Buyer shall indemnify and hold harmless Seller, the directors, officers, employees, attorneys, and agents of Seller from and against all liabilities, costs and expenses including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by Seller by reason of any injury to or death of any employee of Seller, employee of Buyer, or third party; or damage to the property of Seller, property of Buyer, or property of a third party arising out of or involving Seller's and/or Buyer's maintenance and operation of the Assets during the Interim Period. The foregoing release and indemnity shall apply irrespective of whether said loss, damage, personal injury, or death WAS ALLEGEDLY CAUSED BY THE ASSETS OR THE NEGLIGENCE OF SELLER OR ITS EMPLOYEES. For purposes of the foregoing indemnification, neither party hereto shall be deemed the agent of the other party.
- C. Indemnity and Release Prior to Closing. The parties desire to permit Buyer to have access to the Assets prior to closing to aid in the transfer of the Assets. The parties also agree that Buyer shall assume the risks of loss and liability with respect to the Assets due to Buyer's access and use of the Assets prior to closing. Accordingly:
 - Seller hereby gives Buyer permission to access and use the Assets as required to
 assist Buyer in planning and implementing the transfer of the Assets contemplated
 by this Agreement.
 - Buyer hereby agrees to reimburse Seller for any and all repair or replacement costs
 incurred by Seller due to the loss of or damage to any of the Assets arising out of
 or related to Buyer's access and use prior to closing.

- 3. Buyer shall indemnify and hold harmless Seller, the directors, officers, employees, attorneys, and agents of Seller from and against all liabilities, costs and expenses including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by Seller by reason of any injury to or death of any employee of Seller, employee of Buyer, or third party; or damage to the property of Seller, property of Buyer or property of any third party arising out of or related to Buyer's access or use of the Assets prior to closing. The foregoing release and indemnity shall apply irrespective of whether said loss, damage, personal injury, or death WAS ALLEGEDLY CAUSED BY THE ASSETS OR THE NEGLIGENCE OF SELLER OR ITS EMPLOYEES. For purposes of the foregoing indemnification, neither party hereto shall be deemed the agent of the other party.
- D. **Estoppel.** The foregoing provisions of this Article may be pleaded as a full and complete defense to, and may be used as a basis for, enjoining any action, suit, or other proceeding that may be instituted, prosecuted or attempted in breach of the foregoing provisions, except for an action based on a breach of this Agreement.

ARTICLE XI NOTICES

Notices hereunder may be given by any means reasonably calculated to timely apprise the other party of the subject matter thereof and no notice shall be deemed deficient if in writing, or promptly confirmed in writing, and personally delivered, by express courier, or mailed first-class, postage prepaid to:

or to the attention of such other individuals or at such other addresses of which the parties may give notice from time to time. Notice shall be deemed given on (i) the date of delivery or refusal in the case of personal delivery, (ii) the delivery or refusal date, as specified on the return receipt, in the case of over-night courier, express courier, or registered or certified mail or (iii) when received by the person to whom it is addressed in the case of a fax or e-mail.

ARTICLE XII FORCE MAJEURE

- A. Force Majeure. Neither party shall be liable under this Agreement for damages occasioned by delay in performance or failure to perform its obligations under this Agreement, if the delay or failure results from causes beyond its reasonable control and without the fault or negligence of the party so failing to perform or its contractors or agents.
- B. **Notice.** The party whose performance is affected shall immediately notify the other party indicating the cause and expected duration of the event of <u>force majeure</u> and the delay which it will cause and it shall continue to keep the other party notified of the situation.
- C. Obligations of Affected Party. The party whose performance is affected by an event of force majeure shall use all reasonable efforts to avoid or minimize the consequences of delay or failure, shall continue with its obligations after the cause of the delay or failure ceases to exist, but shall not be required to settle a strike, work stoppage, or other labor disputes.

ARTICLE XIII TERMINATION

This Agreement may be cancelled by mutual written agreement of the parties prior to closing for

any reason. In the event the parties cancel this Agreement pursuant to this section and the Agreement's approval by the Commission is pending, both parties shall take all actions necessary under 4 CSR 240-2.116 to dismiss any joint application for approval of this Agreement from consideration by the Commission. In the event a party cancels this Agreement pursuant to this section and the Agreement has been approved by the Commission, both parties shall file with the Commission a written notice signed by both parties indicating they are terminating the Agreement. Each party shall pay the costs and expenses incurred by it in connection with this Agreement, and no party (or any of its officers, directors, employees, agents, attorneys, representatives, or shareholders) shall be liable to any other party for any costs, expenses, or damages, except as provided in this Agreement, and neither party shall have any liability or further obligation to the other party to this Agreement.

ARTICLE XIV MISCELLANEOUS

- A. Amendments. No modification, amendment, deletion or other change in this Agreement shall be effective for any purpose, unless specifically set forth, in writing, and signed by both Parties. Except for written agreements that change the dates set forth in Section III.B, no modification, amendment, deletion or other change in this Agreement shall be effective for any purpose, unless it is approved by the Commission.
- B. Headings. Headings and titles contained in this Agreement are included for convenience only and shall not be considered for purposes of interpretation of this Agreement.
- C. Joint Application and Impact of Commission or Court Orders. Each party shall cooperate with the other in obtaining all necessary permits and approvals of regulatory authorities and shall do all such things as are reasonably required to permit the completion of the transactions contemplated herein in an orderly, efficient and timely manner. Seller shall make a good faith effort to file by December 1, 2001, for the approvals of the sale referred to herein. If the Commission does not approve the provisions of this Agreement, then it shall be nullified and of no legal effect between the parties. Further, if any part of this Agreement is declared invalid or void by a court or agency of competent jurisdiction, then the whole Agreement shall be deemed invalid and

void.

- D. **Survival.** Obligations under this Agreement, which by their nature would continue beyond the termination, cancellation or expiration of this Agreement, shall survive termination, cancellation or expiration of this Agreement. All representations and warranties, and rights and duties hereunder, except for those that are fully executed at the closing, shall survive the closing.
- E. Expenses. Except as otherwise expressly provided herein, all expenses incurred by the parties hereto in connection with or related to the authorization, preparation and execution of this Agreement and the closing of the transactions contemplated hereby including, without limitation, the fees and expenses of agents, representatives, counsel and accountants employed by any such party, shall be borne solely and entirely by the party which has incurred same.
- F. No Waiver. If a party has waived a right under this Agreement on any one or more occasions, such action shall not operate as a waiver of any right under this Agreement on any other occasion. Likewise, if a party has failed to require strict performance of an obligation under this Agreement, such action shall not release the other party from any other obligation under this Agreement, or the same obligation on any other occasion.
- G. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with, and its validity shall be determined under, the laws of the State of Missouri.
- H. Agreement Binding. This Agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective successors and assigns, but shall not be assignable by either party without the prior written consent of the other party.

1. Brumley Substation

Included in this inventory are approximately:

5000 poles

1000 transformers

2.5 million feet of conductor

UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY FACILITIES NOT TO BE PURCHASED BY GASCOSAGE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

The Assets of Seller not to be conveyed to Buyer at closing shall include:

- 1. revenue meters,
- 2. 34.5 kV transformers, regulators, and reclosures,
- all transmission line facilities above 34.5kV, and 3.
- 4. the Mobile N substation currently located at Keethtown Substation.

In addition, AmerenUE will retain all necessary distribution facilities required to serve its customers not transferred under this Agreement.



FIRST AMENDMENT TO TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT Missouri Public Service Commission

This First Amendment to the Territorial Agreement (the "First Amendment") is entered into as of this ________, and between Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE, a Missouri corporation with offices at One Ameren Plaza, 1901 Chouteau Avenue, St. Louis Missouri 63103 ("Company"), and Gascosage Electric Cooperative, a Missouri cooperative corporation with offices at Highway 28, Drawer G, Dixon, Missouri 65459 ("Cooperative").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Company and Cooperative have heretofore executed and delivered a certain Territorial Agreement (the "Territorial Agreement") dated as of the 13th day of November, 1997, which sets forth the electric service areas of both Company and Cooperative in Camden, Miller, Maries, Phelps, and Pulaski Counties.

WHEREAS, The Territorial Agreement was approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Commission") by Report and Order in Case No. EO-98-279, which became effective on June 23, 1998.

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend the Territorial Agreement in order to change the electric service areas of both Company and Cooperative in Miller County and a small portion of Camden County.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises set forth above and the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein, Company and Cooperative agree as follows:

Exhibit 1 to the Territorial Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the Exhibit
 1 that is attached to this First Amendment.

- 2. Exhibit 2A to the Territorial Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the Exhibit 2A that is attached to this First Amendment.
- 3. Exhibit 2B to the Territorial Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the Exhibit 2B that is attached to this First Amendment.
- 4. Exhibit 3 to the Territorial Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the Exhibit 3 that is attached to this First Amendment.
- 5. Paragraph 3 of the Territorial Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - "3. The electric service area of the Company under this Agreement shall be that portion of Camden (Exhibit 2A), Miller (Exhibit 2B) and Maries (Exhibit 2C) Counties as is described in Exhibit 1 to this Agreement and as substantially illustrated by the line as shown on the maps marked Exhibit 2A thru 2C to this Agreement, all exhibits being incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Agreement as if fully set out verbatim. The Company may serve within municipalities that are located in Company's service area, pursuant to this Agreement."
- 6. Paragraph 4 of the Territorial Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - "4. The electric service area of Cooperative under this Agreement shall be all of Pulaski County (Exhibit (2D) and that portion of Camden (Exhibit 2A), Miller (Exhibit 2B), Maries (Exhibit 2C), and Phelps (Exhibit 2E) Counties as is described in Exhibit 3 to this Agreement and as substantially illustrated by the line as shown on the maps marked Exhibit 2B thru 2E to this Agreement, both exhibits being incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Agreement as if fully set out verbatim. The Cooperative may serve within municipalities that are located in Cooperative's service area, pursuant to this Agreement."
- 7. The following paragraph is added to the Territorial Agreement:
 - "16. The parties recognize that the Cooperative will have to construct extensive facilities to serve customers in the New Electric Service Area. Therefore, for the customer's convenience, during the time period between the filing date of this First Amendment to the

Territorial Agreement with the Commission and one year after the Effective Date of said amendment, if a customer requests new electric service for a New Structure located in the New Electric Service Area, the parties will meet and determine the party to serve the New Structure. In the event the Cooperative cannot serve the Structure, the New Structure shall be served by Company. As used in this section, the term "Effective Date" shall be defined as the effective date of the order issued by the Commission pursuant to RSMo. Section 394.312, approving the First Amendment to this Agreement and the term "New Electric Service Area" shall be defined as that area in Camden and Miller Counties outside the electric service area of the Cooperative, as described in the original Territorial Agreement, which is now included in the electric service area of the Cooperative, as described in the First Amendment to the Territorial Agreement."

- 8. This First Amendment shall become effective upon approval by the Commission pursuant to RSMo. Section 394.312. Performance of the parties is contingent upon all of the following conditions precedent having occurred no later than December 31, 2001. (This date can be extended by written agreement of the parties.):
 - (a) all required approvals of the Cooperative's Board of Directors; and
 - (b) approval of the transaction by the Commission, including but not limited to, a finding that this Agreement, in total, is not detrimental to the public interest and that the First Amendment shall not impair the Company's certificates of convenience and necessity in any other respect within Camden and Miller Counties.

If the above conditions precedent have not been satisfied by the date set by the parties, this First Amendment shall be null and void *ab initio*.

9. This First Amendment may be terminated at any time by mutual consent of Company and Cooperative. The termination of this Agreement shall be effective on the date the Commission receives a notice, signed by both Company and Cooperative, of their

decision to terminate this First Amendment. If the transactions contemplated by this first Amendment are terminated as provided herein, (i) the Territorial Agreement, as approved by the Commission by Report and Order in Case No. EO-98-279, shall remain in effect in accordance with its original terms, (ii) the parties shall be entitled to serve all Structures they are serving on the effective termination date of the First Amendment, (iii) each party shall pay the costs and expenses incurred by it in connection with terminating this First Amendment, and (iv) no party (or its parent corporation, officers, directors, employees, agents, attorneys, representatives, or shareholders) shall be liable to any other party for any costs, expenses, or damages; except as provided herein, neither party shall have any liability or further obligation to the other party to this First Amendment

 EXCEPT to the extent herein amended or modified, the Territorial Agreement is not otherwise amended or modified.
