MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW Algonquin Water Resources of Missouri, LLC (Algonquin or Company), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.335 and 4 CSR 240-3.640, requests leave to file this request and an extension of time to prepare and file its Water and Sewer Annual Report (Annual Report). In support thereof, the Company states as follows to the Commission:

- 1. Algonquin is a Missouri limited liability company duly organized, validly existing and in good standing in all respects with its principal office and place of business at 12725 West Indian School, Suite D101, Avondale, AZ 85323, Voice 623-935-9367, Fax 623-935-1020. Algonquin provides water service and sewer service to customers in the State of Missouri.
- 2. A certified copy of Algonquin's Certificate of Good Standing was filed with the Commission in Case No. WO-2005-0206. Said document is incorporated herein by reference in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(G) and made a part hereof for all purposes. Algonquin is a "water corporation," a "sewer corporation," and a "public utility" as those terms are defined in Section 386.020 RSMo and as such is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission as provided by law.

- 3. Algonquin has no pending actions or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it involving customer service or rates having occurred within three (3) years from the date of this Application. The Company has no assessment fees that are overdue. Algonquin's activities are not the primary focus of any cases pending before the Commission.

- 5. Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-3.335(1) and 4 CSR 240-3.640(1) require all sewer and water utilities to "submit an annual report to the commission on or before April 15 of each year." However, Section 393.140(6) authorizes the Commission to "extend the time prescribed for cause shown." Further, Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-3.335(6) and 4 CSR 240-3.640(6) permit a thirty (30) day extension upon the filing of a request.
- 6. The report due on April 15, 2007, would have been only Algonquin's second annual report filing since beginning service in Missouri. Accordingly, Algonquin personnel are not yet accustomed to this annual filing requirement and failed to file the Company's Water and Sewer Annual Report by April 15, 2007, or to request extension by that date.

- 7. When Algonquin began to provide service to Missouri, its personnel were located at a different address than the one identified above. When Algonquin's local counsel was contacted last week by Staff personnel, it became apparent that the address for the Company identified in EFIS was not updated when Algonquin moved to its current location. Accordingly, a Commission notice concerning the annual report was returned to the Commission as undeliverable.
- 8. After last week's contact, Algonquin has provided current contact information to the Commission records center so that EFIS can be corrected. Algonquin is also working to complete its annual report expeditiously. Algonquin believes that it will be able to complete and file the annual report by May 23, 2007. Accordingly, Algonquin seeks leave to file a request for extension and, hereby, also requests an extension until May 23, 2007, to file its Water and Sewer Annual Report.
- 9. Algonquin believes that the requested extension will not prejudice any party as it would be only a few days longer than the thirty (30) day extension provided for by the Commission's rules.

WHEREFORE, Algonquin respectfully requests that the Commission issue its Order granting Algonquin's Motion for Leave and, thereafter, grant Algonquin an extension of time until May 23, 2007, to file its Water and Sewer Annual Report.
