ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION TO MIDWEST ENERGY CONSUMER'S GROUP

On October 9, 2014, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a Petition for an Accounting Authority Order. The Commission directed its Data Center to notify all parties to Kansas City Power & Light Company's (KCP&L) last rate case, and set November 7, 2014, as the deadline for requests to intervene. On October 24, Midwest Energy Consumer's Group (MECG), a party to KCPL's last rate case, requested intervention.

Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080 (13) parties are allowed 10 days to respond to pleading. No party has responded to MECG's request to intervene and more than 10 days have expired since the company filed its request. The Commission will therefore grant intervention to MECG.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Midwest Energy Consumer's Group's request for intervention is granted

2. This order shall be effective upon issuance.
