ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO LATE-FILE INITIAL REPORT

On March 10, 2021, the Commission approved a Stipulation and Agreement allowing Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri to use a deferral accounting mechanism to track and defer costs and other financial impacts related to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Stipulation and Agreement required Ameren Missouri to file its initial report providing information about 2020 two weeks after the Stipulation and Agreement was approved. On May 17, 2021, Ameren Missouri filed a request for leave to late-file its initial report. Ameren Missouri states that it inadvertently overlooked the initial reporting requirement, but contends no party will be prejudiced by granting its request.

The Commission issued an order allowing other parties until May 27, 2021, to file any objections or other responses to Ameren Missouri's request. No party has objected or otherwise responded to Ameren Missouri's request. Therefore, the Commission will grant the unopposed request to late-file the initial report regarding 2020 information.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Ameren Missouri is granted leave to late-file the initial report regarding 2020 information.
 - 2. This order is effective when issued.
