On March 10, 2021, the Commission approved a Stipulation and Agreement and granted Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's request to use a deferral accounting mechanism to track and defer costs and other financial impacts related to the COVID-19 pandemic. On May 17, 2021, Ameren Missouri filed information required under the Stipulation and Agreement for the first quarter of 2021. Ameren Missouri also filed a request to late-file the calendar year 2020 information.

Ameren Missouri states that it inadvertently overlooked the initial reporting requirement for that information. Ameren Missouri asserts that no party will be prejudiced by granting its request because the deferred amounts will be addressed in its currently pending electric rate case (File No. ER-2021-0240). Ameren Missouri further states that it submitted the deferral information in that rate case on March 31, 2021.

The Commission will set a time for any objections or other responses to Ameren Missouri's request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any objections or other responses to Ameren Missouri's request to late-file

its 2020 initial report shall be filed no later than May 27, 2021.
