FOR FILING REQUESTS TO INTERVENE**

On December 30, 2011, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("Companies") filed an application for an Accounting Authority Order (AAO) that would allow the Companies to undertake certain accounting procedures in connection with their electrical operations in relation to the costs of compliance with Missouri's Renewable Energy Standard Law. The Commission will direct notice and will establish a deadline for applications to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon each party to File No. ER-2010-0355 and ER-2010-0356.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within the Companies' service areas.
3. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing the Companies' service areas and to the news media serving the Companies' service areas.
