### SECOND STATUS REPORT

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its *Status Report* submitted on behalf of all parties in this matter, hereby states as follows:

1. On January 29, 2021, Ameren Missouri filed its unopposed *Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule and Request for Expedited Treatment* ("Motion") because of ongoing, productive settlement discussions among the parties. On that same day, the Commission sustained Ameren Missouri's motion by issuing its *Order Suspending the Procedural Schedule* (the "Order"). The *Order* suspended the procedural schedule in this case and, as suggested by Ameren Missouri's *Motion*, directed the parties to file either a status report or settlement agreement no later than February 10, 2021.

2. On February 10, 2021 Staff filed, on behalf of all parties, a status report requesting further suspension of the procedural schedule, stating that the parties are productively pursuing settlement and finalization is pending agreement on the proper base sums against which to compare certain incremental costs that would be subject to deferral if the Commission approves an accounting authority order for Ameren Missouri. The Commission granted this request and ordered that a status report or settlement agreement be filed by February 19, 2021.

3. Staff and Ameren are nearly in agreement on the base amounts, and Staff expects to complete its review in the next few days. Because discussions remain ongoing, Staff asks that the Commission issue an order continuing suspension of the ordered procedural schedule in this matter and requiring the parties to file an additional status report or a settlement agreement by March 1, 2021.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will accept this Second Status Report and grant such other and further relief as is just in the circumstances.
