## ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: November 22, 2021 Effective Date: November 22, 2021

On June 1, 2021,¹ the Empire District Electric Company ("Liberty") filed its Winter Storm Uri AAO Application (Application) requesting an accounting authority order ("AAO") regarding costs incurred during the extreme weather event of February of 2021. On June 28, the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") filed a motion to dismiss Liberty's AAO application. Liberty responded on July 8, and OPC replied to Liberty's response on July 13. On October 8, the Commission Staff (Staff) filed its recommendation. On October 22, the Commission ordered Staff and OPC to clarify their respective recommendations and positions and set a deadline for Liberty to file any objection or reply thereto.

On November 5, Staff filed its Staff Clarification, recommending the Commission issue an order approving Liberty's AAO with the stipulation, however, that carrying costs not be included in the deferral. On November 12, OPC filed its response to the October 22 order, asking the Commission to dismiss Liberty's application. On November 19, Liberty filed its response to the October 22 order, asking the Commission to deny OPC's Motion to Dismiss and to authorize Liberty to track and defer to a regulatory

asset the costs associated with Storm URI, including carrying costs. The Commission will order the parties to confer and file a joint proposed procedural schedule.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No later than December 2, 2021, the parties shall confer and file a joint proposed procedural schedule.
  - 2. The joint proposed procedural schedule shall propose:
    - Deadlines for filing direct, rebuttal, and surrebuttal testimony
    - Deadlines for filing a joint list of issues, order of witnesses, order of cross examination, and order of opening statements
    - Deadlines for filing statements of position
    - Dates for an evidentiary hearing
    - A briefing schedule.
  - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
