1 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Good morning. This is
2 Tuesday, February 14, 2012. The Commission has
3 set this time for a procedural conference in File
4 No. EU-2012-0131. This is captioned as: In the
5 Matter of the Application of Kansas City Power and
6 Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations
7 Company for the Issuance of an Accounting Authority
8 Order Relating to Its Electrical Operations.

9 My name is Michael Bushmann. I'm the
10 regulatory law judge assigned to this case.

11 We'll begin by taking entries of

2 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Thank you, Mr. Conrad.

4 MS. BAKER: Thank you. Christina Baker and
5 Lewis Mills, Junior, P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson City,
6 Missouri 65102, appearing on behalf of the Office of
7 the Public Counsel.

8 JUDGE BUSHMANN: And Staff of the
9 Commission.

10 MR. WILLIAMS: Nathan Williams and John
11 Borgmeyer, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri
12 65102.

13 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Thank you.

14 Are there any preliminary matters that
15 need to be addressed at this point?

16 (No response.)

17 JUDGE BUSHMANN: It's not a contested case,
18 and no one's asked for a hearing at this point, so I
19 haven't really treated it as a -- where we would need
20 to have a procedural schedule filed yet.

21 I would like to have a status report,
22 joint status report, filed in about ten days, so why
23 don't we say that the Staff will file that on
24 February 24, and I can issue an order later today
25 for the parties for that.

1 I know that you are wanting to have your
2 conversations about this case. Are there any other
3 additional issues or matters that we need to take up
4 on the record before we get to that stage?

5 (No response.)

6 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Okay. So what we'll do,
7 then, is we'll adjourn so that you can have those
8 conversations, and we're off the record.
