## ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND

On September 27, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2020 triennial integrated resource planning (IRP) compliance filing. Several stakeholders responded to that filing on March 31, 2021. By rule, Ameren Missouri has sixty days to respond to the stakeholder filings, meaning the company's response is due by May 28, 2021

On May 25, 2021, Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking that the date for filing its response be extended until June 11, 2021 to allow more time for discussions with stakeholder. The motion represents that it has contacted all parties and none oppose the requested extension. Based on the motion's representation, the Commission will treat the requested extension as unopposed.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(15) allows the Commission to modify the response periods regarding the IRP filing for good cause shown. The Commission finds that good cause has been shown to extend the time to respond.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri's Request for Extension of Time is granted and the sixty-day period for a joint filing pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-22.080(9) and for responses pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-22.080(10) is extended through June 11, 2021.
