

## **METER AND USAGE DATA HANDOUT**

At a minimum, Evergy Missouri West and Evergy Metro should retain and include in their next rate case the following data and information:

1. For each rate schedule the total number of customers served on that rate schedule on the first day of the month and the last day of the month;
2. For each rate schedule the number of customers served on that rate schedule on the first day of the month and the last day of the month for which interval meter readings are obtained;
3. For each rate schedule on which customers may take service at various voltages, the number of customers served at each voltage on the first day of the month and the last day of the month;
4. For each rate schedule on which customers may take service at various voltages, the number of customers served at each voltage on the first day of the month and the last day of the month for which interval meter readings are obtained;
5. For each rate schedule on which customers may take service at various voltages, the sum of customers' interval meter readings, by interval and by voltage;
6. For each rate schedule on which service is available at a single voltage, the sum of customers' interval meter readings, by interval;
7. If any internal adjustments to customer interval data are necessary for the company's billing system to bill the interval data referenced in parts 5 and 6, such adjustments should be applied to each interval recording prior to the customers' data being summed for each interval;
8. Individual customer interval data shall be retained for a minimum of thirty-six months. If individual data is acquired by the company in intervals of less than one hour in duration, such data shall be retained in intervals of no less than one hour.
