The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed a verified petition for financing order on January 19, 2022.¹ On February 1, the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) filed a timely application to intervene. The Commission finds that allowing MECG to participate will serve the public interest. The Commission will grant the application to intervene.
