STAFF’S MOTION TO OPEN WORKING DOCKET

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and files this Motion to open a working docket with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) stating the following:

1. The Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (“MEEIA”) is codified at Section 393.1075, RSMo (Supp. 2012).

2. The Commission has promulgated rules¹ to implement MEEIA, in particular, Rule 4 CSR 240-20.094(8)(B), which provides:

State-Wide Collaboratives. Electric utilities and their stakeholders shall form a state-wide advisory collaborative to: 1) address the creation of a technical resource manual that includes values for deemed savings, 2) provide the opportunity for the sharing, among utilities and other stakeholders, of lessons learned from demand-side program planning and implementation, and 3) create a forum for discussing statewide policy issues. Collaborative meetings are encouraged to occur at least once each calendar year. Staff shall provide notice of the statewide collaborative meetings and interested persons may attend such meetings.

3. The Commission’s establishment of a working docket will assist the state-wide advisory collaborative in the collection and evaluation of information and serve as a repository for documents and comments. A docket will provide transparency during this process and will allow any person with an interest in this matter to view documents and submit comments or documents.

4. Staff recommends the Commission provide notice of its establishment of a working docket in this matter along with the notice in Attachment A to: the interveners in the various utilities' MEEIA filings, File Nos. EO-2012-0206, EO-2012-0142, EO-2012-0009 and EO-2012-0008; the Office of the Public Counsel; Missouri's regulated electric and natural gas corporations; the Missouri Public Utility Alliance; the Missouri Association of Municipal Utilities; the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission; the Municipal Gas Commission of Missouri; the Association of Missouri Electric Cooperatives; and the Missouri Association of Natural Gas Operators.

WHEREFORE, Staff moves for the Commission to establish a working docket for the purposes described above, and recommends the Commission provide notice of the docket along with the collaborative notice in Attachment A to the entities listed in paragraph four (4) above along with any other person the Commission deems necessary.
