ORDER OPENING A WORKING PROCEEDING REGARDING EMERGING ISSUES, AND SCHEDULING A WORKSHOP MEETING

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On March 24, 2017, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the

Commission to open a proceeding to permit Staff to gather information and to facilitate

discussions regarding emerging issues related to utility regulation. In particular, Staff

intends to address:

- the regulation of solar energy;
- the Commission's role in installation of advanced metering infrastructure;
- the Commission's role regarding Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) and Pay as You Save (PAYS) programs;
- the implementation of modified rate design proposals; and
- the Commission's role in the promotion of a competitive market for plug-in electrical vehicles.

After gathering information, Staff intends to submit a report to the Commission regarding its review of these matters. To start the process, Staff asks the Commission to schedule a workshop meeting. The Commission will do as Staff requests.¹

This file will serve as a repository for documents and comments. Using this file, any person with an interest in this matter may view documents and may submit comments or documents. As this is not a contested case, anyone may file a comment without legal counsel. Intervention requests are not necessary to submit comments or view documents.

electric utilities. (Ameren Missouri ER-2016-0179, KCP&L ER-2016-0285, KCPL-GMO ER-2016-0156, and Empire ER-2016-0023)

2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the news media and to the members of the General Assembly.

3. A workshop meeting will be held on May 18, 2017, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in Room 450 (Ballroom) at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison St., Jefferson City, MO 65102. A copy of Staff's agenda for that meeting is attached to this order.

Interested parties are invited to provide information to Staff before the workshop meeting on the designated topics, including examples from other states, legal implications, and answers to the questions posed by Staff. Such information may be provided directly to Staff, or may be filed in this file. Such information should be submitted by May 1, 2017.
