**NOTICE OF WORKSHOP**

**COMES NOW** the Staff (“Staff”) of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”), by and through counsel, and states the following:

1. On February 24, 2021, the Commission opened this docket to evaluate the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (FERC) Order 2222, regarding the regulation of distributed energy resource (DER) aggregators and their participation in the capacity, energy and ancillary service markets operated by Regional Transmission Organizations (RTO) and Independent System Operators (ISO).

2. Staff now files this *Notice* to announce an informational workshop to be held June 29, 2021, beginning at 9:00 a.m., to gather information and insight into this topic. The workshop will take place at the Governor’s Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, MO 65101, and will include the option to participate virtually or in-person. Staff will file the agenda for the workshop in this docket.

3. Staff requests that interested stakeholders provide questions that they would like to see addressed at the workshop by filing them in this docket no later than June 16, 2021.

4. Staff also requests that interested stakeholders notify Staff counsel Whitney Payne at [whitney.payne@psc.mo.gov](mailto:whitney.payne@psc.mo.gov), whether they will participate in the

meeting virtually or in-person. Staff asks that stakeholders provide this information to Staff counsel no later than June 25, 2021.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff requests that the Commission issue an order setting the workshop for June 29, 2021, beginning at 9:00 a.m.; asking interested parties to file responses to Staff's questions no later than June 16, 2021; asking interested parties to notify Staff counsel as to whether they will participate virtually or in-person no later than June 25, 2021; and grant such other and further relief as is just in the circumstances.
