ORDER OPENING A WORKING CASE

Issue Date: December 21, 2022

Effective Date: December 21, 2022

On December 8, 2022, the Commission issued its *Amended Report and Order* (Order). The Order stated that the Commission would open a separate working case to allow stakeholder collaboration with Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (together, “Evergy”) related to the details of Evergy’s Time-of-Use (TOU) rate implementation plan. As ordered by the Commission, Evergy’s new default TOU rates will have a phased-in implementation from October 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023. The time prior to October 1, 2023, has been ordered as a lead-in time for customer education and outreach.

The Commission will direct Evergy to file a status report addressing the operations, communications, and expectations of the workshop. The status report may include any other pertinent details.

This file shall serve as a repository for documents and comments. Using this file, anyone with an interest in this matter may view documents and may submit any pertinent

responsive comments or documents. As this is not a contested case, anyone may file a comment without counsel and without *ex parte* constraints (arising from this matter). Intervention requests are not necessary to submit comments, view documents, or to attend a workshop meeting.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This case is established as a repository for documents and comments regarding Evergy's introduction of default TOU rates.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to all parties in Evergy's most recent rate cases, ER-2022-0129 and ER-2022-0130.
3. Evergy shall file a status report as described in the body of this order no later than January 17, 2023.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
