1 JUDGE PRIDGEN: Good afternoon. We are 2 on the record. This is the prehearing conference in Case No. EU-2012-0130. I'm Ron Pridgen. I'm the 3 4 regulatory law judge assigned to preside over this 5 prehearing conference. It's being held on February 15, 2012, at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon. 6 7 We're in the Governor Office Building in Jefferson 8 City, Missouri. 9 I would like to get oral entries of appearance from counsel, please, beginning with Kansas 10 11 City Power & Light Company. MR. FISCHER: Let the record reflect the 12 13 appearance of James M. Fischer of Fischer and Dority, 14 PC, 101 Madison Street, Suite 400, Jefferson City, 15 Missouri, appearing on behalf of the Company. 16 JUDGE PRIDGEN: Mr. Fisher, thank you. 17 On behalf of the Staff of the Commission, 18 please. 19 MS. McCLOWRY: Meghan McClowry and Nathan 20 Williams for the Staff of the Public Service Commission. Our business address is P.O. Box 360, 21 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. 22 23 JUDGE PRIDGEN: Ms. McClowry, thank you. 24 On behalf of the Office of the Public 25 Counsel, please.

1	MR. MILLS: On behalf of the Office of the

14	Conrad, Finnegan Conrad & Peterson. Our address is
15	3100 Broadway, Suite 1209, Kansas City, Missouri 64111
16	and, your Honor, I will provide the reporter with the
17	sheet with all that information. Thank you.
18	JUDGE PRIDGEN: Mr. Conrad, thank you.
19	Have I missed anyone?
20	(No response.)
21	JUDGE PRIDGEN: All right. I don't recall
22	any pending motions, any pending applications to
23	intervene, and so normally this is about the time I
24	would wrap up the on-the-record portion and let you
25	know you have access to this room and this phone for

as long as you need, and I'm up on the ninth
 floor, if you have any scheduling issues or
 problems.

4 Is there anything I can do for the 5 parties?

6 MR. WILLIAMS: Judge, I'll let you know 7 that Staff is going to propose that we have a 8 technical conference to get some information from 9 the Company regarding its application.

10JUDGE PRIDGEN: Okay. And I don't11know -- I'll move the phone here in just a12moment. That was Mr. Williams from Staff. He13believes Staff would propose a technical14conference, in case those on the phone are unable15to hear.

16 Is there anything else I can do for the 17 parties before I excuse myself? Mr. Conrad.

MR. CONRAD: Judge, one item, and I just checked here just a few moments ago, we are still not able to access the HC materials. I suspect that is because there hasn't been a formal order or anything that the record center would do, but I'd appreciate it if, in the meantime, hopefully the Company can supply that.

25 I think there were a couple of numbers,

but they did file both HC and NP. I can only see 1 2 the NP stuff. If your Honor would be so kind as 3 to make whatever directive it is --4 JUDGE PRIDGEN: Certainly. 5 MR. CONRAD: -- necessary to permit us authorization of that, I would appreciate that. 6 7 JUDGE PRIDGEN: Certainly. And I 8 show -- I thought that I double-checked the docket 9 sheet. I show that the Commission allowed Praxair intervention on January 23, so you should be able 10 11 to see it, and I will check with the data center 12 and see what the problem is. 13 Mr. Conrad, thank you. 14 Anything else I can do for the parties? 15 MR. MILLS: Judge, that brings me up to 16 one of the two things that I wanted to address on the record today. First being, I don't think that 17 the Company has demonstrated any reason in its 18 19 applications why the figures that it's considered 20 highly-confidential should be highly-confidential, so I think maybe when we're off the record they 21 22 can explain that to me. 23 JUDGE PRIDGEN: Okay. 24 MR. MILLS: I don't see any real 25 justification for it.

1 And second, just while we're on the 2 record, I just have to say this: Given the 3 Commission's recent decision in the MGE case, given all the other cases that KCP&L has got going 4 5 on with us, I think it's unconscionable that KCP&L is pursuing this accounting authority order. 6 7 It's simply taking up everybody's 8 resources for no good reason given the 9 Commission's MGE decision. It's just going to be dragging me into something that the outcome is 10 11 pretty much foregone. I just wanted to put that on the record, and I appreciate it. 12 13 JUDGE PRIDGEN: Mr. Mills, thank you. 14 Anything I can do for the parties 15 before the court reporter and I excuse ourselves? 16 No? 17 (No response.) JUDGE PRIDGEN: All right. I'll ask 18 19 everybody on the phone to please stay on the line 20 and we will go off the record. That is the end of the on-the-record portion of the prehearing 21 conference in EU-2012-0130. 22 23 Thank you. We are off the record. 24 (The hearing concluded.) 25
