- JUDGE BURTON: Okay. Let's go ahead and
- 3 go on the record. The time is currently 2:00 on
- 4 August 5th, 2014.
- 5 We're on the record in File No.
- 6 EU-2014-0255 in the matter of the application of
- 7 Kansas City Power & Light Company for the issuance
- 8 an order authorizing construction accounting
