## ORDER GIVING PUBLIC COUNSEL AN OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND

On October 6, 2008, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a petition asking the Commission to open a case to investigate AmerenUE's plans to build a second nuclear generating unit at its Callaway site. The Commission never took any action to open an investigative case, although on March 15, 2009, it ordered AmerenUE to comply with Public Counsel's data requests. Since then, AmerenUE has withdrawn from its efforts to obtain approval to build Callaway 2.

Under the circumstances, it appears Public Counsel's petition requesting an investigation is now moot. However, before dismissing that petition and closing this file, the Commission will offer Public Counsel an opportunity to explain why its petition should not be dismissed as moot.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. If Public Counsel wishes to submit a pleading explaining why its petition to open a case to investigate AmerenUE's plans to build a second nuclear generating unit at its Callaway site should not be dismissed as moot, it shall do so no later than October 9, 2009.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
