ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE

On June 25, 2009, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's (KCPL-GMO's) application for a true-up of its fuel adjustment clause. KCPL-GMO claims an under-recovery of approximately \$1.3 million, while Staff contends the company has over-recovered by approximately \$4 million.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D) provides that KCPL-GMO's proposed Fuel Adjustment Clause rate adjustments will take effect by operations of law sixty days after KCPL-GMO's May 29, 2009 filing unless the Commission suspends that timeline. That means the Commission must act before July 28. Therefore, the Commission will require KCPL-GMO to respond to Staff's recommendation promptly.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall file its response to Staff's Recommendation no later than July 6, 2009.
- 2. Any other party that wishes to respond to Staff's recommendation shall do so no later than July 6, 2009.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
