Enclosed for filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") on behalf of The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire"), please find in electronic format certain revised tariff sheets. These revised tariff sheets are being filed to comply with the Commission's Report and Order issued in Case No. ER-2004-0570 on March 10, 2005 and effective March 27, 2005. The interest rate shall be the prime rate of interest on the day the IEC has been in effect for two (2) years as shown in the Wall Street Journal.
