**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO FILINGS**

The Commission established this working case to consider the potential impacts of current and future Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) rules on the reliability and cost of the electric generation plant operated by Missouri's electric utilities. To that end, the Commission directed Missouri's investor-owned electric utilities, and invited other interested stakeholders, to answer certain questions in writing by August 25, 2014. The Commission recognizes that the utilities and other stakeholders may want to respond to the August 25 written submissions. Therefore, the Commission will establish a time for the filing of such responses.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any utility or other stakeholder wishing to respond to the written submissions to be filed on August 25, 2014, shall do so no later than September 2, 2014.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
