**ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE**

This is a working case regarding an on-going statewide advisory collaborative forum created to deal with issues regarding the implementation of the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA). The Commission is concerned about a particular aspect of energy efficiency and will direct the electric utility participants in this collaborative to file the following information:

1. Provide data showing average per customer increase or decrease in energy usage since 2010;
2. Breakdown that data to show only those customers that utilize budget billing; and
3. Prepare a coefficient correlation and any other relevant statistical measures to show if there is a significant deviation in average energy consumption between customers who use budget billing and customers who do not use budget billing.

After this information is filed, the Commission will afford all participants an opportunity to comment.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Kansas City Power & Light Company, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, and The Empire District Electric Company shall file the information described in the body of this order no later than April 4, 2016.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
