## NOTICE OF EX PARTE CONTACT

On April 2, 2007, in my capacity as Comcast's Government Affairs Director for Missouri, among other states, I attended a meeting at the offices of the Missouri Cable Telecommunications Association to discuss legislation which is pending in the Missouri General Assembly. This meeting was called by House Utilities Committee chair Representative Ed Emery, and involved representatives of several Missouri cable and telecommunications providers. I was unaware that Chairman Jefferson Davis of the Public Service Commission had been invited to the meeting, so I did not know he would be attending. Those in attendance included Representative Emery, Chairman Davis, Greg Harrison of the MCTA, W.R. England, Craig Johnson, and I, along with other industry representatives. During the course of the conversation a telecommunications industry participant broached the instant contested case docket. There was no further discussion of the case, and shortly thereafter the Chairman departed.

I bring this matter to the attention of the Commission and other parties to the case because I am aware of the rules which require disclosure of any discussion of a pending contested matter.
