EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On April 13, 2007, Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks-MPS and Aquila Networks-L&P filed tariff sheets to continue its Fixed Bill Pilot Program. The tariffs were due to go into effect July 1, 2007, and the Commission ordered Staff to file a Recommendation no later than June 21.

On June 15, Aquila asked that the effective date of the tariff be delayed until August 1. Accordingly, on June 20, Staff asked for additional time, namely, until July 23, to file its Recommendation.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time to File Recommendation filed by the Staff of the Commission on June 20, 2007 is granted.
2. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its Recommendation no later than July 23, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on June 21, 2007.
