On June 15, 2007, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL), f/k/a IES Utilities, Inc., and ITC Midwest LLC (ITC) asked the Commission to transfer a certificate of convenience and necessity from IPL to ITC. The applicants ask that the Commission approve this application no later than September 1, 2007.

On August 9, Staff filed a status report in which it asked for relief from a previous Commission requirement that the parties file a proposed procedural schedule no later than August 13. Staff stated that it believed the parties had no dispute, and that Staff could file a Recommendation as early as August 17.

The Commission will grant the relief requested by Staff, and will order Staff to file a Recommendation or, in the alternative, a Status Report.
