## ORDER SCHEDULING AN ON-THE-RECORD PROCEEDING AND DIRECTING AMEREN MISSOURI TO RESPOND

The Commission established this case to facilitate an investigation of matters related to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's plan to retire its Rush Island Generating Station. The Commission would like to question Ameren Missouri about electric capacity issues over the next several years in Ameren Missouri's system and in the broader Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) system. To that end the Commission will schedule an on-the-record proceeding.

At the proceeding, Ameren Missouri should be prepared to explain how it intends to address the issue of securing capacity, both in terms of planning obligations ahead of time, as well as meeting real time load obligations. Ameren Missouri should also address the strategies it will undertake to meet its load in the event of a stressor event in the foreseeable future on both its system and MISO's system.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. An on-the-record proceeding is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on August 17, 2022.

2. The on-the-record proceeding will be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
