On April 14, 2022, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty (Liberty) filed its 2021 Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Report and its 2022 Annual RES Standard Compliance Plan, as required by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8). That rule requires Staff to file reports about the compliance report and plan, and offers other interested persons or entities an opportunity to file comments. Staff filed its report on June 1, 2022.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(F) allows the Commission to direct Liberty to provide additional information or to address any concerns or deficiencies identified by Staff or any other commenter. Before deciding whether any additional information is required or whether any concerns or deficiencies need to be addressed, the Commission will establish a time for the filing of responses to Staff's report.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any person or entity wishing to respond to Staff's Report on Liberty's 2021 Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Report and its 2022 Annual RES Standard Compliance Plan, shall do so no later than June 25, 2022.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
