ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO OBJECT TO INTERVENTION

On April 12, 2016, the Commission directed notice of Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's (collectively, the "Company") applications for approval to discontinue the MEEIA Cycle 2 Home Appliance Recycling Rebate program and set a deadline of April 18, 2016 to request to intervene in this matter. On April 14, 2016, the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy filed a motion to intervene. Since the usual ten days to object to any motion to intervene occurs after the deadline established by the Commission to respond to the Company's applications, the Commission will set a shortened deadline for objecting to intervention.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to object or respond to any application to intervene in this matter shall do so no later than 12:00 p.m. noon on April 19, 2016.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
