On April 17, 2020, The Empire District Electric Company, a Liberty Utilities company (Empire-Liberty), filed an application for approval of a Community Solar Pilot Program. Contemporaneously therewith, Empire-Liberty filed an implementing tariff, which bears an effective date of June 1, 2020.

The Commission directs notice of the pending tariff and application, and sets the time for intervention requests and for a Staff recommendation

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve this notice and order on the county commission for each county in the Missouri service territory of The Empire District Electric Company.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach department shall make this notice and order available to the members of the Missouri General Assembly whose districts include any county in the Missouri service territory of The Empire District Electric Company, and to media serving any county in the Missouri service territory of The Empire District Electric Company.

3. Any application for intervention shall be filed no later than May 4, 2020. Any such filing shall be delivered to:

4. The Commission's Staff shall file a Recommendation on the pending tariff no later than May 7, 2020.

5. Any response to the Staff Recommendation shall be filed no later than May 12, 2020.
