**ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING**

On October 24, 2008, the Commission issued its Final Order of Rulemaking regarding amendments to the Net Metering and Easy Connection Act, 4CSR 240-20.065.

On November 6, 2008, Renew Missouri filed an Application for Rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if “in its judgment sufficient reason therefore shall be made to appear.” The Commission finds that Renew Missouri has failed to establish sufficient reason to grant its application. The Commission will deny the application.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Renew Missouri’s Application for Rehearing is denied.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
