**ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO WITHDRAW**

On August 9, 2011, James P. Zakoura and Constance L. Shidler, of the law firm of Smithyman & Zakoura, Chartered, and Neil S. Sader of The Sader Law Firm filed notices of withdraws for their appearances on behalf of various hospital intervenors in the above captioned files. While counsels did not state a reason for their requested withdrawal, all of the cases are closed and no other party has opposed the withdrawal.

On August 10, 2011, previously mentioned counsel filed requests for the parties they represented in the above captioned matters to withdraw. The reasons cited were to discontinue the cost of participation and conserve financial resources.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(6) allows attorneys to withdraw from representation before the Commission only by leave of the Commission. Because no party has opposed the withdrawal of the requesting parties or their counsel, the Commission will grant leave to withdraw.

1. The parties represented by James P. Zakoura, Constance L. Shidler and Neil S. Sader, as delineated in the respective requests to withdraw filed on August 10, 2011, are granted leave to withdraw. The Commission's Data Center shall remove these parties from the certified service lists to these files.
2. James P. Zakoura, Constance L. Shidler and Neil S. Sader are granted leave to withdraw their appearance in the above captioned files.
3. This order shall become effective immediately on issuance.
