### ORDER APPROVING WNAR TARIFF

Issue Date: September 21, 2023 Effective Date: October 1, 2023

On September 1, 2023, The Empire District Company, d/b/a Liberty (Empire) filed proposed revisions to its Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider (WNAR) tariff sheets. The changes to the WNAR tariff sheets will adjust rates to account for the difference between actual heating degree days and normal heating degree days for the twelvementh period ending September 30, 2024.

On September 13, 2023, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation. Staff reviewed the tariff sheets submitted by Empire and recommended that the Commission approve them.

With this tariff filing, residential customers in Empire's North, Northwest, and South rate districts using 100 ccf in a given billing month will see an estimated \$1.63 increase in their bill from the current WNAR rate. Small general service class customers in those districts that use 100 ccf in a given billing month will see an estimated \$1.90 increase in

their bill from the current WNAR rate. No other responses to the tariff sheets were filed in the time set by the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets should be approved. In addition, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than thirty days so that the order will be effective concurrently with the tariff sheets. Therefore, the Commission will approve these tariff sheets to become effective on October 1, 2023.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet filed by The Empire District Company d/b/a Liberty on September 1, 2023 (Tariff Tracking No. JG-2024-0034) are approved to become effective on October 1, 2023:
