ORDER FINDING NECESSITY FOR RULEMAKING

On May 25, 2001, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a Motion to Open a Case and for a Finding of Necessity for Rulemaking pursuant to Section 536.016, RSMo 2000.¹ The proposed rules would consolidate into a new chapter the filing and reporting requirements found throughout Division 240 Title 4 of the Missouri Code of State Regulations. Staff states that this should make the requirements of the rules easier for the regulated industries to find and comprehend. The practice and procedure rules of Division 240 will remain in Chapter 2. Staff stated that the authority for the rules that will be consolidated into Chapter 3 can be found in Sections 247.172, 386.040, 386.250, 386.310,386.410, 396.610, 386.760, 392.140, 392.200, 392.210, 392.220, 392.248, 392.470, 393.130, 393.290, 393.292, 393.299, and 394.312, RSMo.

Pursuant to Section 536.016, RSMo, a state agency is required to find that a proposed rule is necessary to carry out the purposes of the statute that granted the rulemaking authority based on substantial evidence on the record. Based on the record, the Commission finds that the proposed rules to establish Chapter 3 of Division 240 are

necessary to carry out the purposes of Sections 247.172, 386.040, 386.250, 386.310,386.410, 396.610, 386.760, 392.140, 392.200, 392.210, 392.220, 392.248, 392.470, 393.130, 393.290, 393.292, 393.299, and 394.312, RSMo.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission is authorized in accordance with the procedures of the Commission and applicable procedures of administrative rulemaking to file proposed rules for the Commission's consideration.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on June 17, 2001.


