ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SUSPEND AND DIRECTING FILING

Recent actions by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, particularly decisions issued on December 19, 2001, may affect the issues to be decided and the timing of the decision in this case. In a pleading filed on December 28, AmerenUE asked the Commission to suspend action in this case until March 1, 2002, while it determines how it will respond to the FERC's order. AmerenUE suggests that its response to the FERC may make the issues raised in this case moot.
