# **PUBLIC COUNSEL POSITION STATEMENT**

Comes Now the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) and for its Position Statement states as follows:

- 1. This case involves a proposed sale and transfer of certain electric distribution facilities from Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (Company) to Lewis County Rural Electric Cooperative (Cooperative) and a proposed change in electric supplier for approximately 550 customers in the areas surrounding seven cities. When analyzed on the whole, this proposal does not appear to be detrimental to the public interest. However, the Commission should be aware that the impact on individual customers might vary considerably.
- 2. Public Counsel has chosen to not oppose the Application and decided not to request a hearing in this case based upon several factors. The customer switch appears to provide some operational benefits for both electric suppliers. It is also possible that the customers to be switched would receive a quicker response time in the case of electric outages

and other service problems because the Cooperative has local service crews in closer vicinity to the affected customers. Generally speaking, because Company has a lower customer charge than the Cooperative, low energy users will experience a percentage rate increase, while higher energy users will experience rate decreases on a percentage basis. Customers that would be switched would no longer have rates regulated by the Commission; however, these customers would then have the opportunity to vote for the Cooperative's Board which sets its rates and these customers will have the opportunity in the future to receive capital credits.

WHEREFORE, Public Counsel respectfully requests that the Commission take note of its Position Statement and of the fact that Public Counsel does <u>not</u> request a hearing pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.115.
